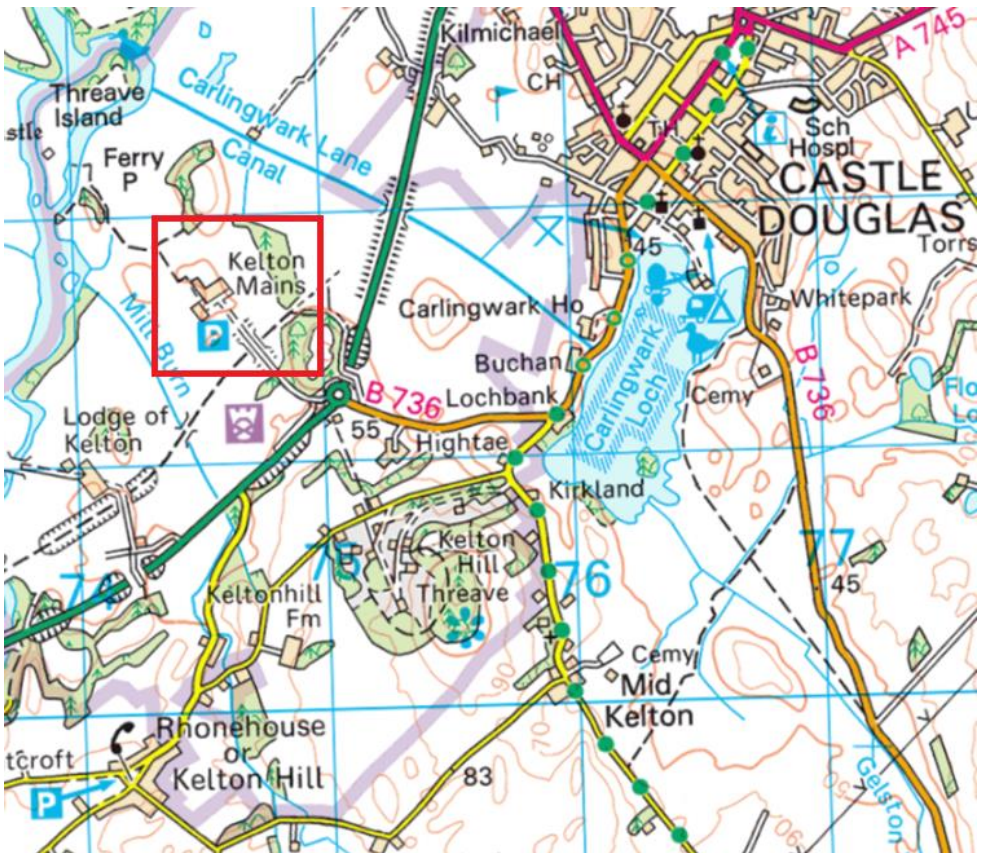

Castle Douglas is located 20 miles west of Dumfries, 42 miles west of Gretna and 55 miles east of Stranraer on the A75.

Travelling from the Stranraer and the west, Kelton Mains is accessed by turning left at the roundabout on the Castle Douglas bypass at the B736 sign posted with a brown sign as Threave Castle Kelton Mains.

Travelling from Dumfries and the east, Kelton Mains is accessed by turning right at the roundabout on the Castle Douglas bypass at the B736 sign posted with a brown sign as Threave Castle Kelton Mains.
